

KS3 Catch-Up Maths New 2018 Programme

KS3 Catch-up Maths provides a focussed boost to knowledge, calculating skills and written arithmetic for students between Years 7 and 9.

Aim of course:

- Build confidence and improve outcomes in level-specific topics
- Apply correct skills required in showing working out in more complex reasoning questions
- Build confidence in using written arithmetic skills
- · Working as part of a group to achieve a common goal

Benefits for Learners:

- Differentiated approach to ensure that all students are challenged
- Can continue in lessons post-course with greater confidence and improved attitudes to maths
- Consolidate techniques and learn new ones in performing calculations

Example of what this would look like:

Morning CT to assess current knowledge, followed by expert delivery of content and differentiated work sheets to practise the skills covered. Maths games and activities to break up the sessions, followed by a PM CT to assess daily progress.

5 days

Course Structure:

5 hour long sessions per day, includes Day 1 and Day 5 exam and daily CTs

Exams Used:

Bespoke assessments created specifically for measuring progress and impact over the duration of the programme, which can be easily mapped to each day of the programme. Quantifiable impact is more easily measured post-course. QLA provided post course to allow continued lesson focus on any topic elements identified as needing additional support.
